Buyer and Seller agree to the following conditions of sale:

Congratulations on the purchase of your new puppy from Pawsh Bernedoodles! We've made every effort to provide you with a happy and healthy puppy, and are confident you have many, many happy years ahead with your new bundle of joy. Your puppy will be vaccinated and dewormed as scheduled. You'll be given health records to share with your veterinarian. Here are some things to note:

1. This contract is for the original buyer that purchased a puppy from Pawsh Bernedoodles. This health guarantee is void if the puppy has not had a secondary vet exam within 72 hours after purchasing, proper veterinary care, adequate diet or exercise, or has been over- or undervaccinated. We require a copy of this vet examination/proof of vet visit. In the unlikely event your puppy is found to have life-threatening hereditary congenital defect at this exam, we will replace the puppy with another one of equal value.

2. Pawsh Bernedoodles guarantees the puppy to be in good health at the time of adoption. Puppy is guaranteed for 1 year from date of birth against any serious health issues. If, within this time period, a life-threatening congenital defect is found, a replacement puppy will be given of equal value. We may request the return of the puppy before any replacement is given; if so, the puppy must be returned to us with the registration papers within 24 hours at no expense to the breeder. The puppy must be accompanied by written veterinarian reports from two nonassociated veterinarians. Replacement will be subject to availability (within 6 months).

3. We do not refund money.

4. If, in the unlikely event the puppy dies within this 1-year time period due to a congenital defect, a statement from the veterinarian is required before any action will be taken by the breeder. If the cause is unknown, an autopsy will be required.

5. A diagnosis of coccidiosis or Giardia, or parasites such as these do not render a puppy unhealthy.

6. This guarantee does not include non-life-threatening or temporary disorders such as uneven bites, undescended testicles, Demodex mange, injuries, inguinal or umbilical hernias, fleas, ticks or ear mites, kennel cough, intestinal worms and parasites, scabies, Eye Entropion, Cherry Eye and allergies.

7. Breeder is not responsible for Parvo, Distemper or Corona Virus after 48 hours of the sale; these diseases are highly contagious and can be contacted immediately after leaving the

breeder.

8. If your puppy is diagnosed with hip or elbow dysplasia before 2 years of age and it is determined by two non-associated veterinarians (buyer's veterinarian, and veterinarian of Pawsh's choice), to be genetic and not caused by abuse, injury, trauma, neglect, obesity or any other non-hereditary factor, breeder will provide a replacement puppy of equal value in exchange for puppy. PennHip report and letter from veterinarian is required stating puppy has received proper checkups.

9. Buyer agrees to ensure puppy's health by providing good food, housing and good medical care to keep health guarantee in effect. Responsible owner/buyers will provide puppy with routine preventive care and all immunizations and exams by licensed veterinarian. If the buyer is unable to keep the puppy, the buyer must notify Pawsh Bernedoodles so they are aware. Pawsh Bernedoodles will help the buyer find a new approved home for the puppy. The buyer agrees to not place the puppy in a shelter or rehome the puppy.

10. If terms and conditions are not fulfilled then this contract is null and void.

11. By signing below buyer acknowledges receipt of a copy of this agreement.

12. Breeder will not be responsible for any veterinary expenses, or any other expenses incurred by the buyer.

13. The breeder is not responsible if puppy size or temperament is not as expected, nor changes in coat or eye color.

14. Bernedoodles are inherently a mixed breed, not purebred, therefore Pawsh's puppies may carry DNA from distant ancestors or DNA from dogs of a different breed.

15. Buyer is aware that puppies can have certain common ailments upon coming home. UTIs, parasites, ear infections, and allergy issues are all common. While we routinely deworm/vaccinate and monitor for potential UTIs and ear infections, sometimes the stress of leaving the breeder causes issues to flare up. The buyer understands it will be their responsibility to treat and care for their new puppy once they leave the breeder.
